There is a contest for the Best Restored & Best Original in each category (Massey, Ford, JD etc.), so stick around to get your trophy. Judging for each category will be completed by 2:00pm and we will give the trophies at that time for you to display with pride throughout the rest of the day. But that's not all from those winners will be chosen Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show. These trophies will be given at 5:00p.m. So please stay to the end and support our winners. There will also be a Parade of Power at 2:45 p.m., so that you can drive your beauty through the festival grounds and past the grandstand to show it off!! All proceeds from the festival go to Scholarships for students planning to further their education in Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal or Environmental Science.

DATE/TIME: Saturday, September 10, 2011 -- 9:00am until 6:00pm, set-up between 6am and 8:30am. We ask that you have all your equipment unloaded and in place by 8:30am. **ALL** vendors, tractors, displays, etc. are to stay until 6:00pm. At that time you may begin to breakdown booths and vehicles will be allowed in to load. **RAIN DATE:** Set for the following Saturday, September 17, 2011.

LOCATION: On The front lawn of Richlands Primary School.

PARADE: There is a parade through town to kick-off the morning. It begins at 9:00am. Line-up is in the high school parking lot (next door to the festival grounds) beginning at 8:00am. There is a \$1.00 entry fee, payable at line up. We hope that you will show your pride by parading through town on your beauty.

USE OF PREMISES: Vendors deem harmless the Onslow County School District, Richlands Primary School, Richlands Friends of Farmers (committee members), and the Town of Richlands . agreeing to not hold the above mentioned responsible for damage or loss of any kind to the exhibit or articles, or any injury caused by the exhibitors/vendors, and further agrees that his or her area will be left clean and in an orderly manner.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- **Absolutely no alcoholic beverages of any kind will be sold or brought into the festival!!**
- All vendors must keep the area clean and free of trash.
- **NO** Animals allowed of any kind. **Service animals permitted.
- **NO** Tobacco products allowed. Smoking is prohibited on school grounds.
- All vehicles must be out of the festival area before 9:00am. Vehicles **WILL NOT** be allowed back in the festival area until **AFTER** 6:00pm

FACILITIES: Only Porta-potty/johns will be available for use. No running water, electricity, or shade is provided. All vendors agree to bring their own means of shade/tent for the day. All food vendors must have the proper equipment as deemed by the Onslow County Health Dept. in regard to running water and all other regulated needs.

DEADLINE: Please fill out the enclosed form and return to us by Sept. 5th, so we know you're coming

COMPLIANCE: Failure to comply with the above restrictions and requirements may result in dismissal from the show and restriction from further festival participation. Your cooperation with the terms of this contract is appreciated.
